

**MINUTES**  
**Special Called Town Council Meeting**  
**June 26, 2018**

Council Attendance: Councilmen: Allen Gallman, Chad Hawkins, and Mike Hawkins.

Administrative Attendance: Karen Livingston, Town Administrator; Michelle Bundrick, Clerk Treasurer; Ed West, Utility Director and Lisa Senn, Town Attorney.

Council Absence: Mayor Derek Underwood and Councilman Robert Martin.

Administrative Absence: Lieutenant Bodiford.

Mayor Pro-Tem Chad Hawkins called the Special Called Meeting to order and welcomed everyone. He asked Councilman Gallman to open with prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of Business License Ordinance:**

A **MOTION** by Councilman Allen Gallman to accept 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of the Business License Ordinance; seconded by Councilman Mike Hawkins, and so approved unanimously.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of 2018-0619-An Ordinance Acting on a Request to Amend the Official Zoning Map Established Pursuant to Zoning Ordinance of The Town of Prosperity Adopted April 20, 1999, so as to Rezone a Zero and Sixty-Nine Hundredths (0.69) Acre Real Estate Parcel Designated as TMS Parcel No. 462-2-1-45 from Single Family Residential (R-10) to General Residential (R-7):**

Mayor Pro-Tem Chad Hawkins asked to postpone to the next Council meeting.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of 2018-2019 Budget:**

Mayor Pro-Tem Chad Hawkins stated the Total Revenues for the General Fund proposed for the 2018-2019 Budget is \$594,000. He stated the Total Revenues for the Utility Fund is \$2,189,530. He stated the total Operating Budget for The Town of Prosperity is

\$2,783,530; with the percentage change of 3.48 percent. He stated our total Millage would be 41 mills which would be a 3.4 mills increase.

**A MOTION** by Councilman Allen Gallman to accept the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of the 2018-2019 Budget; seconded by Councilman Mike Hawkins, and so approved unanimously.

**Interconnection Standard Policy (Net Metering):**

Mayor Pro-Tem Chad Hawkins stated he had no issues with this policy and appreciated Council passing last meeting.

**GENERAL COMMENTS:**

Mayor Pro-Tem Chad Hawkins stated Mayor Underwood would like the Parking and Sign Ordinance on the Agenda for next month. Mayor Pro-Tem stated he had been contacted by a Business owner that was not pleased with the soliciting for the same kind of business for Hoppin'. Mrs. Livingston stated the vendors we had last year had already committed to be here again for this year's festival.

Councilman Mike Hawkins stated he had received a phone call from a Lady that worked in the Square asking if parking is limited to thirty minutes. He stated two hours is a reasonable amount of time to park downtown. He stated people who work downtown should not take up customer parking. Mayor Pro-Tem Chad Hawkins stated the thirty minute signs are still up at the Drugstore. Mrs. Livingston stated we are waiting on the final inspection before taking the signs down.

Mayor Pro-Tem Chad Hawkins adjourned the meeting at 7:06p.m.
